Volunteer Role: Relief Feeder




Relief feeders do the same work as the regular feeders, but on an occasional rather than weekly basis. They cover for sickness, holidays and work commitments, and assist feeders if needed. They have the same training and are well placed to become regular feeders if they wish when an opportunity arises.

The swans are fed with mixed corn every afternoon, at the boathouse steps on Bromwich Parade. In mid-winter work starts at about 3.30, gradually moving towards 4.30 or 5.00 at midsummer.

The role:

- monitor the swans for problems
- litter pick
- clean the feeding area
- feed the swans
- tidy the food store

The whole process takes about an hour. Volunteers have an initial training period and are then supported going forward.
